## SATs

Year 6 SATs tests are in the week of 14<sup>th</sup> - 17<sup>th</sup> May. We try to keep disruption around school to a minimum, therefore, swimming will not go ahead this week. ## Paperless

In this digital age, it is our intention to become paperless with regards to parental communication, as of September. We will keep parents fully informed of progress towards this, so that you can easily be alerted to information that is relevant.

## Sun Protection

Now that the weather seems to becoming hotter, can I remind you of the following? Can you please ensure that you:



- Apply a high factor sun cream to your child before school (**ideally one which lasts all day**).
- Send sun cream to school with your child for re-application (**if required**).
- Ensure that they have a water bottle in school daily.
- Ensure children have sun hats for break times.

We have areas of shade under umbrellas and trees. Some sun creams can be applied once daily and will protect all day, however many need to be re-applied. **Our priority is for the safety of your children.** Before each break, staff will allow the children to apply cream, with clear instruction to apply to areas such as arms, neck, ears and face. Children can select a friend to help them apply the cream if required; however staff will be supervising and will assist if necessary. To avoid the eventuality of allergic reactions, children will be discouraged from sharing cream.

**Please DO NOT send in SPRAY sun creams with your child as this can make polished flooring slippery.**

## PE Kit

It is essential that children have appropriate kit for both indoor and outdoor PE. Trainers are necessary for outdoors and plimsoles or bare feet for indoors.
