## **Numeracy**

Numbers and Place Value Recognise place value in 4 digit numbers. Count backwards using negative numbers. Round any number to 10,100,1000. find 1000 more or les than given numbers.

Order and compare 4 digit numbers using < >. Use written methods to add/subtract 3/4 digit numbers. Solve simple 2 step problems. Recall tables facts up to 12x12. Multiply 2 digit numbers by one digit using a written method. Continue to practise mental methods for +, -, x,  $\dot{x}$ .

<u>Geometry and Measures</u> Use a range of measures with increasing accuracy. Convert between different units e.g. kilometres/metres. Use decimal notation to record metric measures and money. Solve problems involving measures/money. Read, write, time- analogue/digital. Use correct mathematical vocabulary to describe and classify 2Dshapes. Identify lines of symmetry. Use co-ordinates to describe position.

<u>Statistics</u> Collect, present and interpret data in a variety of forms, including bar charts and time graphs. Begin to use a range of scales.
