Outdoor Play And Learning (OPAL)

Although this only started two weeks before Christmas, OPAL play is really well embedded. The zoned areas work



well, allowing children from Year 1 to 6 to play anywhere they choose on the school play site. The cold weather did not deter the children from playing in the mud kitchen or the digging area - it just took a lot more effort! Space hoppers work just as well in the snow! We have recently replaced the old dining tables that were utilised for table tennis, with purpose built tables. This is proving very popular. Money raised by "The Friends of Westmoor" has been used to purchase a summerhouse. As this was an ex-display model, Oakenclough Buildings agreed to supply and install this for £2000. Donated carpet will be used to provide a warm surface for the children to sit, along with bean bags and twinkly lights. Children can bring their own colouring pencils/pens and notebooks etc. to use in this area. In addition, pogo sticks have been purchased to be used in a new zone for "Craze of the Week". In this area, the items on offer will change weekly, from pogo sticks to diablos to French skips, etc. We initially tried to get sponsorship for a 64m2 sandpit, however this has not been possible. We have asked a company to quote for this and will keep you updated. We hope to have this installed in the Easter break. "Parent Play Days" will be offered after Easter, so that you can come in to explore the activities on offer, alongside your child. If your child does not have wellies in school, please try to do so, so that they can access all activities on offer.
